2 small containers of hand sanitizer to keep inside desk

6 travel size packs of tissues to keep inside desk

Extra clothing placed in a large Ziploc bag labeled with the child's name—socks, underwear, uniform pants for boys, leggings/tights for girls, etc.

Raincoat with hood and rain boots – These will remain at school. Please label them and place them in a jumbo Ziploc bag.

- 1 box of basic 24 crayons
- 1 box of traditional color washable thin markers
- 1 box of traditional color washable thick markers
- 1 fine tip black Sharpie marker
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 4 large glue sticks
- 1 yellow highlighter
- 1 large pencil eraser
- 1 pair of child size scissors
- 1 pack of 12 pencils (Please do not send a pencil sharpener.)
- 4 black Expo dry-erase markers

- 1 small whiteboard eraser
- 2 plain plastic pocket folders (no brads on the inside) (1 red, 1 yellow)
- 1 inch 3-ring binder for STEM
- 1 set of headphones with a **straight jack input** Place in a plastic Ziploc bag labeled with the child's name.
