### **General expectations of School uniform:**

- **Belts** are required for all pants and shorts having belt loops, unless a banded shirt is worn.
- Shirts must be tucked unless banded.
- **Hair** (unusual color or style), body art/tattoos, and/or accessories that attract attention and/or cause a distraction are not permitted.
- **SHORTS**: Approved uniform shorts may be worn September 1st-30th, and May 1st- end of school (June).

## **General expectations of Chapel (Dress) Uniform:**

• Chapel uniform is worn for Chapel (Every Wednesday) and designated school events.

#### **Additional Expectations:**

- ALL uniform pieces to be Labeled with student names on the inside if not included under the
  crest.
- **Jewelry** should be kept to a minimum
- Hair may be worn with a STJES plaid headband or bow or a solid navy or white ribbons
- **Sweatpants** should not be worn under jumpers or skirts.
- Cold Weather Clothing Students will be spending a significant amount of time outside and should come to school dressed in appropriate cold weather clothing, including coats, hats, gloves, etc.
- ALL students are asked to keep a pair of **Rain boots** at school for outdoor activities.

**Upper School (5-8) Physical Education Uniform -** Please LABEL all pieces of the PE uniform. The student uniform for PE includes a t-shirt that is representative of their place on either the Blue or Gold team. The following is a list of items required for US PE uniforms:

- Navy shorts with STJES crest or STJES
- Navy or Gold T-shirt with STJES crest
- Navy sweatpants and sweatshirt with STJES
- Athletic white socks
- OPTIONAL: Extra pair of athletic shoes with laces for PE (all white or black) to be kept in PE locker

**All School or designated Out of Uniform Days** - There are designated Out of Uniform days scheduled throughout the school year, and these occasionally coincide with special themes. **Students in Grades 5-8** are expected to change into PE uniforms on Out of Uniform days.

### The following items of clothing are NOT permitted on Out of Uniform Days:

- See-through outfits, bare midriffs, open backs, low-cut tops, tube tops, tank tops, halter-tops, strapless, mesh or sleeveless shirts. No skin should be visible between shirts and pants while seated or while hands are overhead. Undergarments must be covered.
- Flip-flops, Slippers, Crocs and/or Slides may NOT be worn due to potential safety hazards.
- Logos/designs of questionable taste, torn, or revealing items.
- As with regular uniform policy, shorts may only be worn the months of September, May, and June and must be at a minimum of fingertip length. Information will be communicated by the school as to specific dates in these months.
