2 **small** containers of hand sanitizer to keep inside desk

8 travel size packs of tissues to keep inside desk

Extra clothing placed in a **large Ziploc bag labeled with the child's name**– socks, underwear, uniform pants and shirts, leggings/tights, jumper, etc.

Raincoat with hood and rain boots – These will remain at school. **Please label them and place them in a jumbo Ziploc bag.**

1 box of basic 24 crayons

1 box of traditional color washable thick markers

1 box of colored pencils

1 fine tip black Sharpie marker

2 yellow highlighters

3 large glue sticks

1 large pencil eraser

1 pair of child size scissors (right or left-handed)

1 pack of 12 pencils (Please do not send a pencil sharpener.)  
4 Expo dry-erase markers (black, blue, red, green)  
1 small whiteboard eraser  
5 plain plastic pocket folders (no brads on the inside) (1 red, 1 yellow, 1 blue, 1 green, 1 orange)

1 inch 3-ring binder for STEM

1 Sketch Book for Art

1 set of headphones with a **straight jack input** – Place in a plastic Ziploc bag labeled with the child's name.

Wireless Mouse for a Chromebook (right or left handed depending on your child)

2 marble composition books for journal writing (Mead Primary Journal)
